One of the persistent myth about this disease concerns the donating of blood. Health official say that it is not possible to catch blood. Blood banks use sterile throwaway needles and collectio equipment so there is no way that a donor could be exposed. to a blood shortage. It was recently reported that the
incubation period for this diseas is longer than was first believed. I have not yet seen a report on how this change might affect the
current blood supply about the fact that there are large medical facilities (using larg amounts of blood) located Houston, which also has the largest population of gays in the AIDS cases. situation.
Another health myth which ha been around for a long time is that

bad for you as high blood pressure. Wrong! Hypotension, as
low bood pressure is known, is not considered a disease and cannot be the cause of weakness, headache
