Angvidunt To This covstirution
Of the State of Texas, to be Voted on Tuesday, November 6, A, D. 1900.
[H. J. R. No. 35 ]
JOINT RESOLUTION, amending Article 8, of the Constitution of the State of Texra, by adding thereto Sectiou 20, providiug for the organization of irrigation districts, and for the levsing and collection of a tax for the coustructiou of reservoirs, dams aud cauals.
Be it resolved by the Legialature of the State of Texas. That Article 8. of the Coustitution of the State of Texas, be amended by adding therato Section 20 , as follows:
Section 20. In addition to the powers of taxation granted in the foregring sections, it shall bo lawful for the Legislature of exas to authorize the wha owner of the connties of Archer, Bavior, Clas, Wichita and Knox to organize irrigation districts in said countie without regard to countr lines.
Hu makiug provisious for the cost of construction of to levy taxes aud ereate an indebteduess to reat a charve on and be secured by a lien nu the irrigable land for the use and benefit of which said irrigation works have been or may be conatructed. The Lenistature mat have been or may be condructed, The Lpgistature mar sary to contruct irrigation works withiu said territor but no taxes shall be levied nor indebtedness created any district until authorized ry a two-thirds, yote o resideut had owners theren whose lands are easce of irrigation from the proposed works.
