HOUSTON BEATS DALLAS, MOVES INTO FIRST PLACE

Houston pulled out in front of the United States Hockey League southern division today while Kansas City slipped into a tie for the northern bracket lead with the St. Paul Saints.

Houston's Huskies clicked with a last-period game-winning goal 17 seconds after the Dallas Texans tied up their game at Houston last night to win 4-3 and pull two points ahead of the idled Tulsa Oilers. The game was marked by rough play and flying fists as the Texans dropped their third game in four starts.

ACC Faces McMurry In Intra-city Fray

Team Pilot Faces Prison Sentence

WINSTON-SALEM, N. C., Oct. 22 (UP)—Bernard DeForge, former manager of the Reidsville baseball team of the Carolina League, today was under a one-year prison sentence for accepting a bribe to "throw" a game to the Winston-Salem team this spring.

DeForge had pleaded guilty to the charge, saying that he guaranteed Reidsville would lose by at least three runs in order to safeguard gamblers' bets and that he received \$300 when the game was over.

Appearing as defendants with DeForge in the trial which concluded yesterday were W. C. McWaters and Tommy Phillips, used-car dealers of Clover, S. C. However, both McWaters and Phillips were freed of charges that they had offered DeForge the bribe.

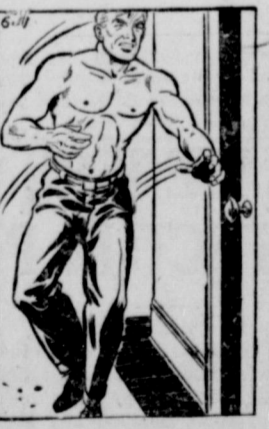

Calves: 300. Steady to weak. Common, medium and good slaughter calves 16.00-24.00, culls 14.00-16.00. Stocker steer calves 24.50 downward and stocker heifer calves 23.00 downward.

Hogs: 300. Butcher hogs weak to 25 lower than Thursday's average, sows 25-50 lower, stocker pigs steady. Top 26.50 paid for good and choice 190-270 lbs. good and choice 160-185 lbs 2.50-26.25. Sows mostly 22.50-24.00, few 24.25. Stocker pigs 20.00-22.00.

Sheep: 1000. Killing classes steady to weak. Common and medium slaughter lambs 20.00-22.50, common to medium slaughter ewes 8.25-9.00. Feeders scarce.
