Mexico Searches For Geo. Ochoa

MEXICO CITY, Nov. 1 (UP)—Mexican police are searching for George Ochoa, wanted in Laredo, Tex., for questioning on two murders, it was learned today.

Ochoa reportedly fled into Mexico to escape capture after two men were shot to death in a Laredo hotel several months ago.

The U. S. Embassy requested assistance of Mexican authorities in capturing Ochoa. Two Mexican special agents were put on his trail. They reportedly have turned up no trace of the hunted man.

An Embassy spokesman said the United States already requested Ochoa's extradition.

"All the necessary documents have been given Mexican authorities," the spokesman said. "Although Ochoa is known to be in Mexico, police have not found him yet."

TEXAS News Briefs

NACOGDOCHES, Tex., Nov. 1 (UP)—Fluorid services were held here this morning for E. M. (Boss) Adams Sr., 72, prominent East

Texas attorney who died yesterday. Adams, a native of Caledonia in Kusk County, had been confined to a hospital since a recent cerebral hemorrhage.

He was graduated from the University of Texas law school in 1904, and during his time at the University played on the first Longhorn football team. He served as Nacogdoches county attorney from 1914 to 1916.

AUSTIN, Tex., Nov. 1 (UP)—Cigarette stamp sales in Texas during October surpassed both the previous month and October of 1948, the State Treasurer's office reported today.

Sales during October totaled \$2,071,922, compared to \$2,052,567 for September and \$1,944,284 during October, 1948.

AUSTIN, Nov. 1 (UP)—A non-sectarian organization recently formed in Texas today called for a religious revival to prevent an atomic war.

George B. Hatley of Austin, president of United Forces For God against Communist said the project for a vast spiritual movement would be pressed by five million adherents of 42 UFFGAC groups.

The only true defense against atomic war, said Hatley, was recognition of God.

SAN ANTONIO, Nov. 1 (UP)—

A ten day old Laredo child died yesterday in an automobile accident at the San Antonio city limits.

The infant, San Juana Rodriguez, was being held in the arms of her mother when the car struck a highway marker, rebounded and crashed into another vehicle. The baby was tossed from the car. San Juana's father, Romario Rodriguez, 19 year old Laredo beet field worker, was driving the car. He and his wife were not injured.

HARLINGEN, Nov. 1 (UP)—Bond of \$1,000 was set today for a 31 year old Houston man charged with negligent homicide in connection with a two car crash that killed one Mexican worker and injured 12 others.

Howard Manley Wisley's semi-trailer allegedly collided with the rear of a truck loaded with 19 Mexican braceros and 99 boxes of grapefruit. Juse Diaz, 38, was killed in the week end crash. 12 others were hospitalized.

Justice of Peace E. W. Anglin bound Wisley over to county court.

HOUSTON, Tex., Nov. 1 (UP)—No trace had been found today of Holman T. Simmons, 47 year old parking lot attendant, who disappeared early Monday.

Also missing from the lot was a 1948 two tone blue Hudson car and \$175 in cash. Simmons' hat and jacket were found in the office, and Frank Wetzel, manager of the parking lot, believed Simmons had been kidnapped.

"He was an old and trusted employe and would not have left of his own accord," Wetzel told police.
