## Ensor House <br> Hit By Fire

| Burning trash, spread by high winds, resulted in a $\$ 20,-$ 000 to $\$ 25,000$ blaze late Saturday afternoon at the brick farm home of Mr. and Mrs. James Ensor, about two miles south of the Oklahoma Lane crossroads. <br> The high winds spread the fire from the trash barrels to the grass where it melted a gas line in the back yard of the home, according to Ensor, turning the gas line into a "blow torch" at the base of the home. The fire spread to the roof where fire extinguisher bombs in the attic exploded, probably preventing the fire from spreading more rapidly. <br> Fire departments from Muleshoe and Farwell were middle part of the roof from collapsing.
