Good pastures may supply all of the minerals essential to the profitable production of big boned beef cattle. If the minerals are present in the soil they pass from the soil through the pasture forage to the animals. But adequate amounts of phosphorus and calcium are not always supplied by natural sources. Soils become worn out-or the minerals may have been lacking in the soil in the first place. In such cases, additional minerals are needed to make up the difference. Ask your county agent for providing adequate minerals for livestock.
