estation as in any way affectin their breakfast tables, but the Flor ida citrus fruit growers have a dif
ferent point of view. The Florid grapefruit and orange crop now re quires on the average more than
$12,000,000$ boxes yearly to get it to 12,000,000 boxes yearly to get it
market. By 1930, if production continues to increase in similar
ratio to that in reeent years, the output will require $40,000,000$ boxes annually. Each box requires about $1 / 2$ board feet in lumber Local southern pine forests ar
the source of the raw material fo he source of the raw material for
these boxes, but the supply is drawn upon also for wooden containers fo the products of Florida truck farms. Truck farm products of the state now call for $13,000,000$ boxes an nually, and this demand also growing.
Forest which do not provide for regrowt has reached a point which makes the question where containers are
