A Flight Into ${ }^{*}$ History


In September 1934, two Black Americans became the first of their race to ay a land plane into Nassau, Bahamas. C. Alfred Anderson of Tuskegee, Alabama (next to plane) and Dr. Alber E. Forsythe of Alantic City, New Jersey (second from right) were among the first Negroes to be
come pilots. They helped to found the flying school at Tuskegee Institute and trained most of the black pilots of World War II. They made their historic flight in a single-engine 98 horse power Monocoupe named the Booker T. Washington. Anderson today is still chief aight instructor

## IT'S NOT EASY <br> But it can be done!



You can get in trouble when you try to enter a busy expressway. You can probably keep out of trouble if you follow a few basic rules.

If the approach to the expressway is long and straight, it is what some of us call a "get up and go" lane. It is designed to allow you to match the speed of your car with the speed of the cars travelling on the expressway, so that (theoretically at least) you can blend in smoothly with the expressway traffic.

When you try to do this, be sure you have spotted a hole in the expressway traffic into which you can blend. Do no accelerate to expressway speed and then slam on your brakes because there is no hole in the traffic. If you do this, you may be rear-ended by a car or truck behind you.

During peak rush hours, you may
have to wait for an op-
portunity to enter the expressway. Be patient. The driver of the car ahead of you may be frightened. Don't try to force him into action by blowing your horn. You could panic him into a tragic crash.

If yours is the first car at the starting line, move out just as soon as it is safe for you to do so. Unnecessary delay can cause a hurry-up motorist behind you to take foolish chances.

Expressway driving is not always easy, but it will probably get worse before it gets better. Practice up on your driving skill, improve your ability to judge speeds and distances, and get ready for tomorrow's supercongested superhighways
