He was represented by Abilene attorney Lee Cox. <br> In the hearing, Judge Sarringer retused to issue a temporary restraining order and ruled in favor of Pack to remain administrator. Pack told The Mail Monday "After four hours of hearings, no evidence was presented at any time by any witness that any money had been embez- | zled or was missing from either estate." <br> He also said, his attorney, Dub Burke of Abilene, planned to tile suit against two Merkel citizens alledging deffamation of character and that his suit would ask for a public apology as well as attorney's tees. <br> Pack told The Mail "I have been stopped on the street many times in the last week and asked if I have been to jail or was in trouble for stealing thousands of dollars. These are viscious rumors and I am filing suit to clear my name, my family's name and to recover attorney's fees." |
