Renter's Insurance: Is it necessary?

Imagine coming home to your apartment and finding everything gone. The local police can investigate, but the chances of recovering your lost property is almost nil.

As of this week, officials with the organization said contributions of almost \$17,000 are needed to finalize construction at the site, located at the corner of 10th and Avenue I.

The following is a list of items and services needed and projected costs:

- Stove hood installation, \$900
- Final heating and A/C, \$500
- Electrical, \$1,500
- Contract labor, \$2,000
- Floor tile and cove base, \$2,717
- Floor tile installation, \$1,500
- Bathroom partitions, lift bars, dispensers, wash basins, etc., \$2,500
- Completion of plumbing and installation of equipment, \$3,000
- Modification and installation of stove hood fire controls, \$800
- Fresh air return system/stove hood, \$600
- Additional panic bars for emergency exit, \$1,500.

Total cost for the above items and services is \$16,917.

Junior/Senior Prom

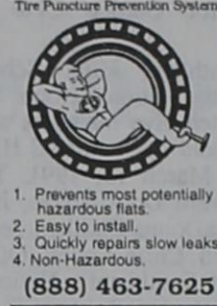
