Gas leak prompts school evacuation

Post ISD officials dismissed all classes about 2:30 p.m. Monday after a gas leak was reported when construction crews hit a main while working near the track facility.

Superintendent Mike Comeaux said workers with Lee Lewis Construction of Lubbock ruptured a 2-inch gas main during excavation work for the campus improvement plan.

After evacuating the elementary and middle schools, which were most threatened by the leak, Comeaux said the decision was made to go ahead and dismiss all classes, including the high school.

Middle school basketball games scheduled in Post that evening also were canceled. Teams from Childress en route to Post were notified to turn around.



Coffee Cookies By Lorrie Coop, Munday

Cookies 1/2 cup granulated sugar 1/2 cup packed brown sugar 1/2 cup butter or margarine, softened 1 egg

1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour 1 tablespoon instant coffee granules

1 teaspoon baking soda 1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup chopped pecans 2 cups semisweet chocolate

chips Icing

1/2 teaspoon instant coffee granules or instant espresso coffee (dry)

1 tablespoon water 1/2 cup powdered sugar Heat oven to 350°F. In large bowl, beat granulated and brown sugars, butter and egg with electric mixer on medium speed, or mix with spoon, until creamy. Stir in flour, 1 tablespoon coffee granules, the baking soda and salt. Stir in pecans and chocolate chips. Drop dough by 1/4 cupfuls about 2 inches apart onto ungreased large cookie sheet. Bake 12 to 15 minutes or until golden brown and edges are set. Cool 4 minutes; remove from cookie sheet to wire rack. Cool completely, about 30 minutes. Meanwhile, in small bowl, dissolve 1/2 teaspoon coffee granules in water. Stir in powdered sugar until smooth and thin enough to drizzle. Drizzle cooled cookies with Coffee Drizzle. Makes 15 cookies.

Cake Mix Cookies

1 cup (8 oz.) sour cream Frosting: 1/2 cup butter, softened 4 cups confectioners' sugar

Food Coloring, optional

3 Tbs. milk

Directions: In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Combine dry ingredients; add to the creamed mixture alternately with sour cream, beating well after each addition (dough will be sticky). Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours or until easy to handle. On a floured surface, roll out dough to 1/4 inch thickness. Cut into desired shapes with floured cookie cutters. Place 1 inch apart on greased cookie sheets. Bake at 375 degrees for 8-12 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool for 1-2 minutes before moving to wire racks.

For frosting, in a large bowl, beat the butter, confectioners' sugar and milk until smoothe. Add food coloring if desired. Frost cookies.

In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, sea salt and cinnamon to combine. Set aside. In the bowl of an electric mixer, cream butter with white and brown sugar until light and fluffy. Add the eggs and vanilla and mix until combined.

Add the flour mixture to the butter mixer and combine on low speed.

Fold in the chocolate chips and marshmallows. Chill dough in refrigerator for 1 hour to overnight (I did one batch right away and another after chilling overnight and found there was no difference.) Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. Line baking pans with parchment paper. I used one 11x17 pan and one 9x13 pan but you can really use any sized pans you want. Lay out graham crackers side by side on the pans as close as possible (they should be touching). I used 16 graham cracker squares on one pan and 10 squares on another. You may have to add or remove graham crackers according to how much dough you have. If you want your cookies thicker you will use more dough and less graham

In a food processor with the knife blade attached... Pulse pecans with 1/4 cup powdered sugar until nuts are very finely ground. Add butter and vanilla and process until smooth, occasionally stopping and scraping the side with a rubber spatula. Add flour, and process until evenly mixed and dough forms.

With floured hands, shape dough into 3/4 inch balls and place them 1 inch apart on an ungreased cookie sheet.

Bake 16-18 minutes or until bottoms are lightly browned and cookies are light golden. Carefully transfer cookies to a wire rack, and cool about 3 minutes. Meanwhile, place the remaining powdered sugar in a small bowl. While still warm, gently roll cookies in powdered sugar to coat. When cool, gently roll cookies again in the powdered sugar. Enjoy!

Place tablespoons of dough on graham crackers about 1-1 1/2 inches apart. I averaged about 1 1/2 tablespoons of dough per graham cracker square as seen in the picture above. Press down slightly with fingertips. Bake for 5 minutes then remove from oven to press Hershey's bar pieces on to the top. You can place as many pieces or as little as you want depending how much chocolate flavor you want. Bake for an additional 5 - 7 minutes or more if your cookies are thicker. They will be done when the edges begin to turn golden brown. Remove to a wire rack to cool. For clean cutting make sure cookies are completely cool and cut with a sharp knife.

Mix softened butter and remaining powdered sugar, add milk for easy spreading consistency. Roll balls in milk, butter, sugar mixture and then in coconut. Let dry. Store snowballs in airtight container. Makes about 3 dozen.
