Colle. <br> Austin, Aug. 8.-No little surprise was occasioned in the state house thts afternoon, following the giving out of a telegram received by Gov. Campbell announcing that President H. H. Harrington of the A. \& M. College had tendered his resignation to the woard of directors, assembled at Corpus Christi, its acceptance and the appointment of R. T. Milner, Commissioner of Agriculture, as Dr. Harrington's suc cessor. The action of the board of dt rectors temporarily disrupts the official family of the State government and occasions some complications. <br> The telegram to the governor was from K. K. Leggett, president of the board. The message did not say, however, whether or not Commissioner Milner had accepted his new honor Gov. Campbell got into long distance telephone communication with Mr. Milner at Corpus Christi a few minutes after receiving the telegram, and learned from the Commissioner of Agricul. ture that he had accepted the appointment.
