"Serna graded 92 per cent on defense and 87 per cent on offense and 60 is usually good enough to win," said Line Coach Corky Criswell. A key play in the game, according to the coaches, was Serna's behind-the-lines tackle of the S-E quarterback on a crucial fourth down play in the second quarter.

### Christmas Seal Campaign Set

Following a planning session Friday on tuberculin skin-testing activities tentatively planned for April in Bovina, local Top of Texas TB and Respiratory Disease Association Director Pearl Cervantez urged residents of Parmer County to support the 1972 Christmas Seal campaign.

"Christmas Seal work involves not only community health programs against TB, as is planned for Bovina," she said, "it also involves a great amount of lung research in the fight against emphysema and other respiratory diseases such as asthma and bronchitis."

Mrs. Cervantez stated that respiratory disease, particularly emphysema, a disease linked to smoking and air pollution, is now the fastest rising cause of death in the United States and is the second greatest cause of all social security disability payments.

# Ponies Come From Behind For 35-7 Win

The Bovina Mustangs improved their District 3-A record to the 5-0 mark here Friday night with a sound 35-7 win over the Springlake-Earth Wolverines.

The Ponies had to come from behind to get the win as they spotted the visitors an early touchdown and the game was closer than the score indicated. The Bovina boys added 21 points in the final period and their halftime lead was only 14-7.

The Wolverines, who were underdogs going into the tilt, surprised the Mustangs with a 75-yard scoring gallop by Halfback Larry Thomas on their first offensive play of the game.

The Mustangs tied the count at 7-7 with 4:12 left to play in the opening period on a 13-yard pass from Quarterback Kim Rundell to Fullback Billy Shelby and Rundell's extra point kick.

The Mustangs went ahead for good late in the second period as the same pass play combination, Rundell to Shelby, worked for a 34-yard scoring play on a fourth down effort with 1:02 remaining before intermission.

Bovina's junior high and junior varsity teams lost all three games to the Springlake-Earth teams Thursday night. The games were played at S-E.

The seventh grade team, dropped the only close decision of the night with a 12-6 loss to S-E's seventh grade. Ruben Salazar scored the only TD for the Colts on a 68-yard pass from Homer Ashley.

The eighth grade Colts dropped a 20-6 tilt to the host squad. Earl Quintana scored from 25 yards out on a power play.

The Mustang Junior Varsity fell to S-E's junior team, 20-0. "We felt like we played a pretty good game, but were just outmanned, outweighed and they had more age," said Coach Corky Criswell.

The JV now has a 4-3 record, winning over Dimmitt, Sudan, Kress and Farwell and losing to Vega, Plains and S-E.

With the slim, seven-point lead, the Ponies battled the Wolverines evenly during the third period, gaining momentum for their scoring explosion in the final period.

Shelby got the third TD early in the final stanza on a five-yard sprint. That made the count

21-7 and the Bovina fans had an opportunity to relax for the first time in the game.

The Mustangs added insurance points minutes later as Halfback Bryan Fillpot scooted through the line and broke into the clear for a 31-yard scoring gallop.

The final TD came with 2:35 remaining on a 25-yard pass play from Rundell to Split End Ben McCain.

The Mustangs had their best passing game of the year as Rundell hit on six of 14, earning 107 yards and three touchdowns through the airways.

Bovina's total offense was 354 yards compared with S-E's 252. The Marrons received the opening kickoff and advanced

downfield 43 yards in four plays with Shelby's 31-yard effort getting the bulk of that before losing possession of the ball on a fumble at the Wolverines' 25.

On the first play from that point, Thomas, who had been playing the quarterback's role in the S-E offense until this game, took a handoff and set sail around right end. The Mustangs couldn't flag him down.

Before the dust had settled Nicho Triana had kicked the extra point and the Mustangs found themselves 0-7 in arrears.

After that, the Wolverines, who were handicapped by four lost fumbles and two passes which were intercepted, made only one serious scoring threat.

That came in the second period with the score knotted. The visitors drove from their own 29 to the Bovina 13 in 11 plays. The drive was halted by a big defensive play when Mustang Guard Tony Serna tackled the quarterback for a four-yard loss as the Wolverines faced a fourth-and-one situation. That stopped the drive, giving the Bovina team possession at its own 17.

Fillpot was the leading ground-gainer for the Ponies as he carried 18 times for a net of 103 yards including the 31-yard score. Shelby made 76 yards in 15 trips. Halfback Jeff McCormick carried the ball 18 times and earned 73 yards. Rundell had a net of minus

five yards as his rushing total suffered because of being dropped for losses on pass attempts.

Rundell threw two completions to Shelby for TD's of 13 and 34 yards, the one to McCain for 25 and six points, one to Tight End Alan Cockerham for 14 and two to Halfback Joe Delgado for 17 and four yards.

The win put the Mustangs in the District 3-A lead as they are the only undefeated team remaining with one scheduled game left on the '72 slate.

With a victory over the Hart Longhorns there Friday night, they will earn the district championship, which will be their first pennant since '65 when they were competing on the Class B level.

The Mustangs were promoted to Class A in '66. This is the first year they have been in contention for the championship this late in the season.

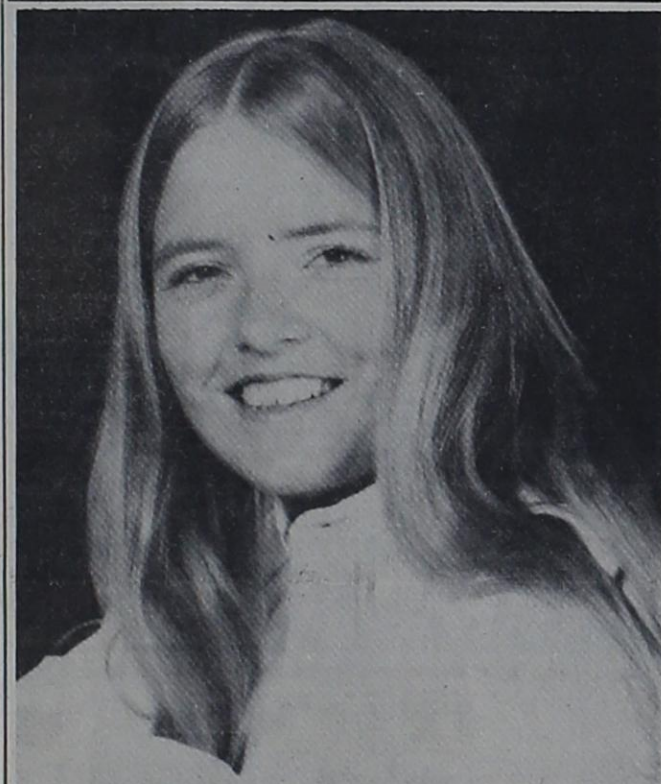

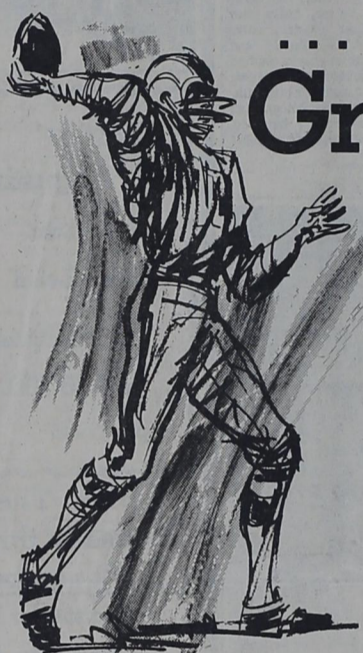
