Austin, Texas, Aug. 21, 1911. Editor Hedley Informer, Hedley, Texas.

Dear Sir:

In reply to your favor of the Howell who has resigned. 15th inst., we beg to advise that where a man moved into this State after January 1st, 1910, and has resided in the State 12 months and in the county 6 months before an election is entitled to vote in said election, in the county of his residence, if he is otherwise a qualified voter, without having paid his poll tax and without a certificate of exemption.
