Mareh 23, 1919. Miss Ozella Jamar
My dear cousin:-I will try answer your kind and welcome day. Sure rom you all. This leaves me ust tine and truly hope you all are the same. What are you do ing these days? I haven't done
any thing today. Sure would like o see you all tonight

Well, you wanted me to tell and landing over here. I got on the boat at New York the 29th of September, and we sailed the auxt day. There were seven boats in the eonvey. Four or five days out, while my compang Was up on deck standing boat mill, we apied a mine about hal mile ahead. Our boat and the on it and disposed of it in six or seven shots. Then we looked just to the right of our boat, a bout 100 jards, and there was some thing that looked like a box. began to feel a little "spotted, but our old gans took a shot at i and tore it all to pieces. Then something else happened; a ma
went overboard; I never did get went overboard; I never did The battleship picked him up in a lit tle while, but I heard he died two or three hours afterwards That's about all the excitemen we bad coming over. The battle ship tarned back four or five days out of France, and the su bit safer. We landed at Brest France, the 15 th of October, and get off the 16th. I surely was tired of the water.
We hiked about four miles in
the rain and had to go to bed without anything to eat-cold wet and hungry. We stayed a
Brest five days, then took the train and rode two days and a oight, landed al Lemans, trayed there one day, left that night on
trueks, and reached the nex stop at 1 o'elock in the morning. Stayed there four days, taking target practice. They told us we would be at the front within ten
