been opened, and donations been opened, and donations

approximately 60,000 a month. Giving blood is a simple proc-
ess, requires but a few minutes tess, requires bart of the dinuter,

is shipped diail in refrigerated
ocntainers to the laboratories where it is processes into dried plasma, a light, straw colored
powder that can be kept indefinite$y$ and transported easily. Plasma is the liquid part of the
blood which remains after the red and white corpuscles have been
