It is the desire of the Post Office Department that prohibited matter be kept from the mails, and one of the best ways to accomplish this result is to let your patrons know what material is unmailable. Much can be accomp-
lished by giving information to high school students and others of impressionable age, as well as
adults who have not had the ter brought to their attention.
It is not possible in a commun ation of this kind to mention in detail all types of unmailable mat-
er. The following list, however is representative of types more commonly dealt with:
