The Informer received an an nouncement this week by Mr. of the Donley County Nationa Farm Loan Association have been maited checks representing a $5 \%$ dividend on their stock
He states that the aim of the Federal Land Ban'ss, operating through locally managed associations, is to bring dependable loan the lowest possible interest rate In 1946 borrowers in Donley County received a total of $10 \%$ in dividends, which brought the average cost of their money to only 3 34-100\%.
Federal Land Bank loans may be secured to purchase land, pay certain agrizuitural indebtedness or to provide buildings and equip ment. Mr. Snith states that at homes, farms, ete., are being financed with these loans.
