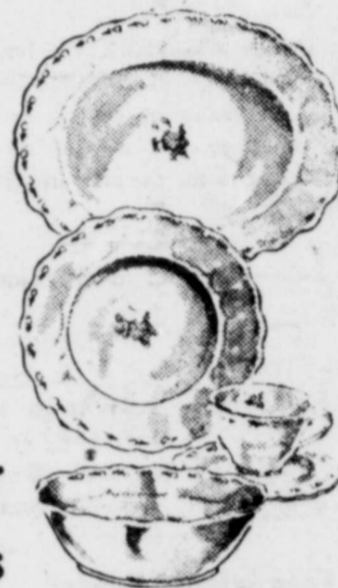

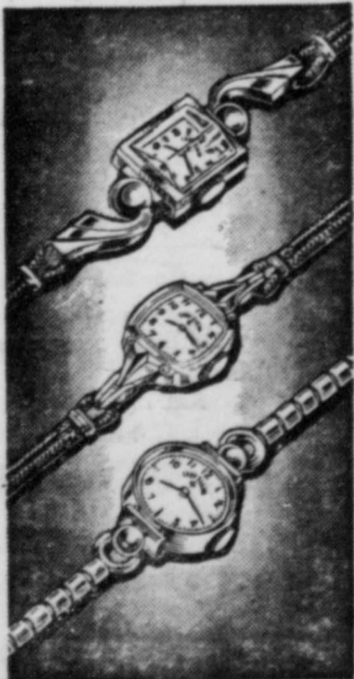

TESTED MEAT RECIPES

TOMATO POT ROAST

2½ to 3 lbs. beef chuck or rump	1 tablespoon salt
2 tablespoons lard	2 cups tomato juice
1 clove of garlic	5 potatoes
	5 carrots

Brown meat slowly in lard. When well browned add tomato juice, salt and garlic. Cover tightly and simmer until tender, approximately 3½ hours. Add vegetables 45 minutes before done. Serves 4 or 5.
