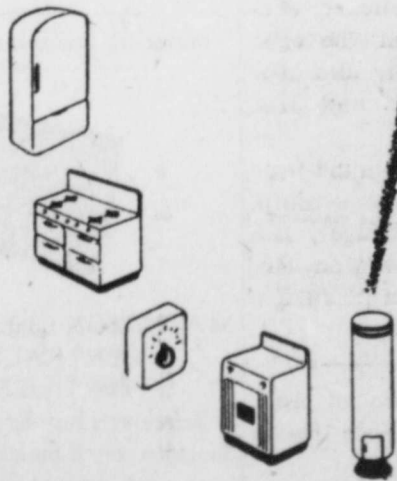

TESTED MEAT RECIPES TONGUE AND PEAS



SERVE WITH
Raw Vegetable Salad

There is good nutrition in any cut of meat

Preparation: Boil tongue in cold water; add 1 1/2 teaspoons salt to each quart of water; bring to a boil; simmer slowly until tender. Allow 1 to 2 hours. Keep tongue in the liquid until cool enough to handle, then remove outer skin.

2 cups cooked tongue 2 cups medium white sauce
1 cup cooked peas 1/2 cup Grated cheese
Slice tongue, then cut into small pieces. Combine with cooked peas and white sauce. Place in buttered casserole. Top with grated cheese. Bake in a moderate oven (350° F.) about 30 minutes.

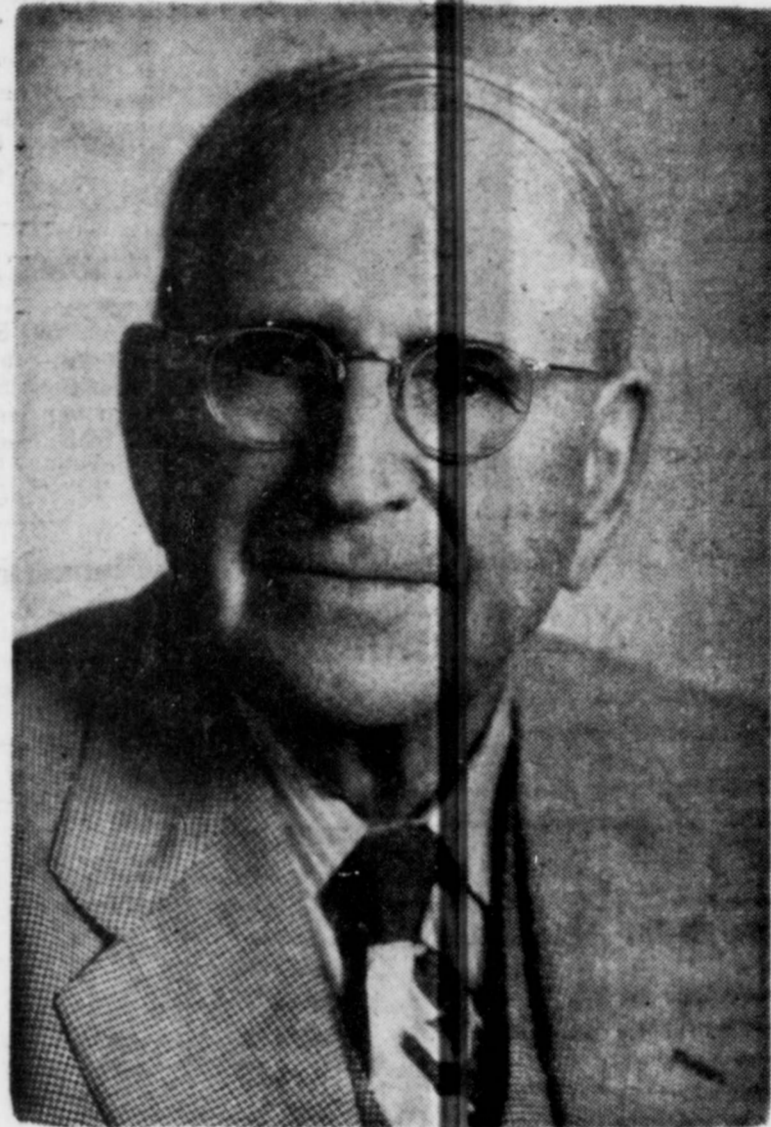
