Hedley Ready for Fourth Annual Cotton Festival

Many Attractions at Cotton Festival

Hedley's fourth annual Cotton Festival, expected to be our biggest and best yet, opens at 10 AM Friday with the opening announcements and introductions.

The pet and novelty parade will be at 11:00, followed in quick succession by the Clarendon colored drum and bugle corps, Clarendon College entertainers, special events, the rodeo, cake walk, address by Paul F. 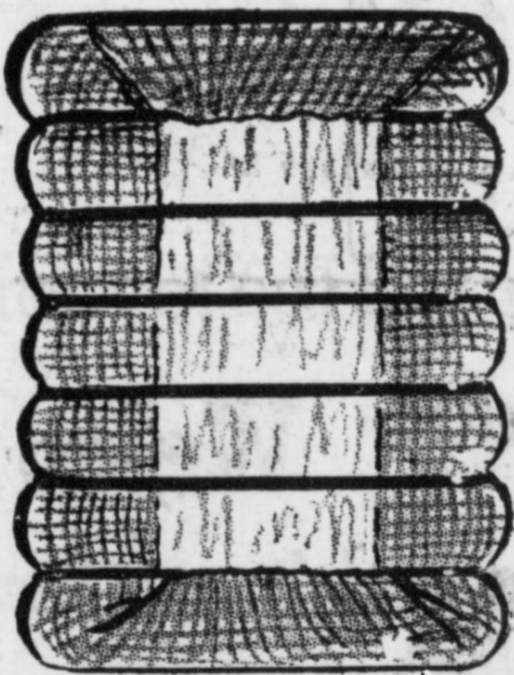
