Register To Vote!

Voters of this area are reminded that the deadline for registering to vote this year is Tuesday Jan. 31. Persons between 21 and 60 years old who do not register by the deadline will not be able to vote in 1967.

The poll tax is no longer required for voting, but everyone between the ages of 21 and 60 who plans to vote must register to be eligible. Registration is not required for persons aged 60 or over who live in a city of less than 10,000 population. There is no charge for registration. Registration may be made by a qualified voter only for himself, spouse, mother, father, son or daughter.

A representative of the sheriff's office will be in Hedley at the City Hall on Saturday, Jan. 28, from 10 a. m. to 4 p. m., in order to assist residents of Hedley and surrounding area to register. Or those wishing to register before that date may do so at the courthouse in Clarendon.



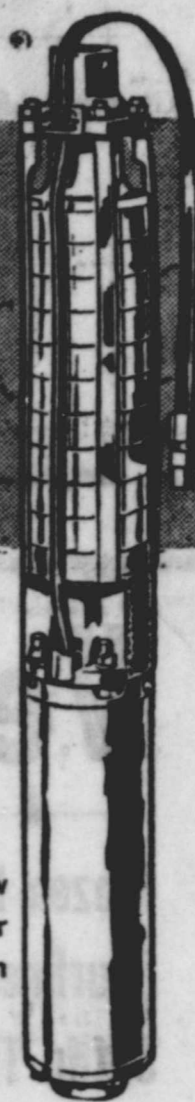
