## Amendments

Texas voters will have six constitutional amendments to vote on Nov 11 A brief outline of the proposed amendmests is as follows:

Amendment No. 1 suthorizee counties to put all county tax revenue into one general fund without regard to source or purpose.
Amendment No 2 permits municipalities, political subdivisions and state supported entitios located within a bospital district to participate in the establishment and operation of mental bealth, mental retardation and public health seryices

Amendment No. 3 extends the veterans laid program by authorizing the sale of $\$ 200$ million of atate bonde to purchase land to be sold to veterans and expands the program to include veterans of Viet Nam

Amendment No 4 suthorizes counties to pay medical, doctor, and hospital bills of county law enforcement officers for injuries received in line of duty and to continue to pay salaries of injured officials during period of incapacitation
Amendment No 5 autborizes
the Parks and Wildlife Dept. to issue and sell general obligation bonds in the amount of $\$ 75 \mathrm{mil}$ lion to finance acquisition and demelopment of lands for state parks and recrestional purposes.
Amendment No 6 permits nonelective state officers and employees to serve in other pon-elective positions under the state or United States government where there is no conflict of interest and where the state will benefit
