## Efficiency, Not Fancy Mrs. Sarah Crawford In Donley Co. Feedlot

Charles Payne has announced that progress is still going full swing on the construction of Donley County Feedlot. Automatic water troughs have arrived from Denver, Oolo, that will be used in the feeding pens These water troughs are heated by electricity in the winter time to keep the water at a more desirable temperature for the cattle The temperature is controlled by a thermostat that will maintain a desirable temperature even in the coldest weather. This will maintain a higher gain per day and also an increase in feed efficiency.

Charles Payne stated that water well had been drilled and derirable amount of good water has been found The well consists of about 50 feet of water sand which will provide an abundance of water for several hundred head of cattle under extreme heat conditions.

Concrete aprons have been put in for cattle to stand on while eating Bunk feeders are now being installed The cattle will be fed twice daily. Some trials will be run on feeding cattle 3 times



Transfer of 1969 Cotton Allotments

The final date to file an application for the transfer of 1969 cotton allotments is Dec. 31, 1968. A cotton producer may transfer his allotment by sale or lease within the county. Transfer by sale or another farm owned or controlled made out of Donley County.

1969 Cotton Marketing Quota

The referendum will be held during the period Dec 2 through Contributions should be sent to Dec 6 Voting will be by mail and ballots and instructions will be mailed to each known eligible voter prior to Dec 2 Notices of allotments and yields will also be mailed to all producers prior to the referendum.

> If quotas are approved by at least two thirds of the upland cotton growers voting, the program under which payments are made to cooperators will be in effect for 1969.





Commodity Loans


