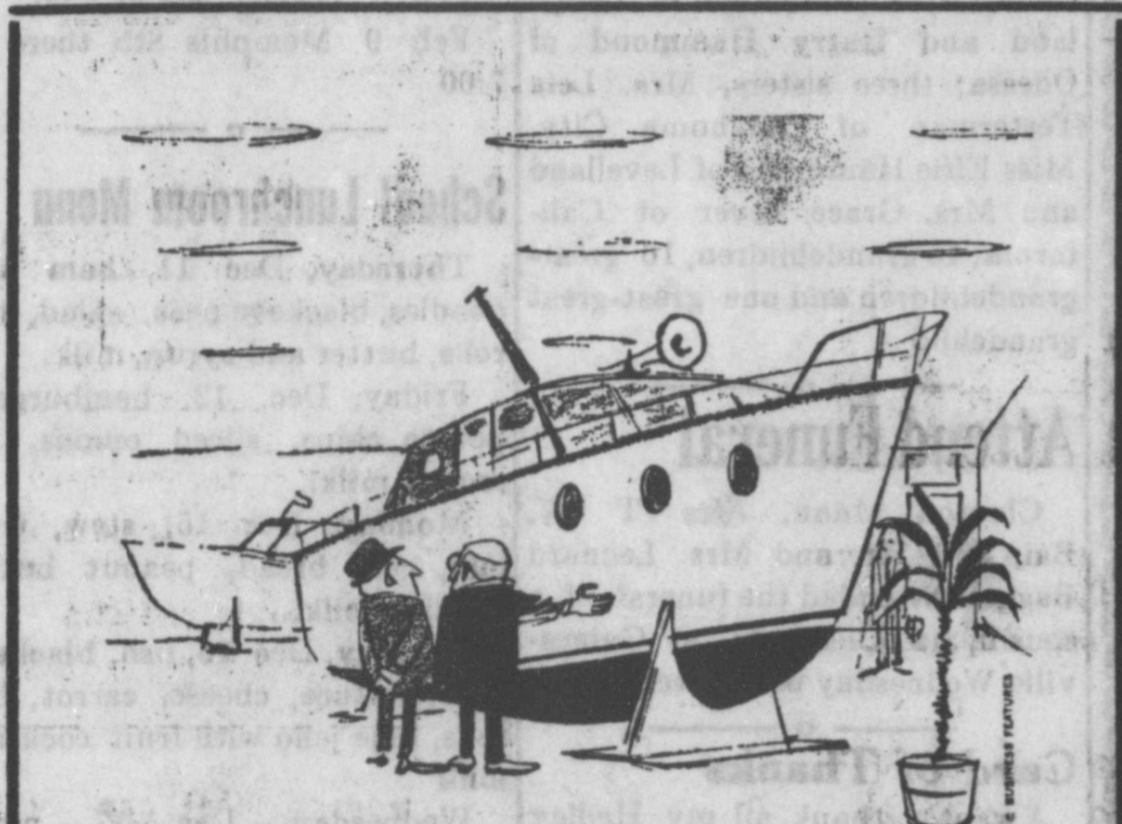

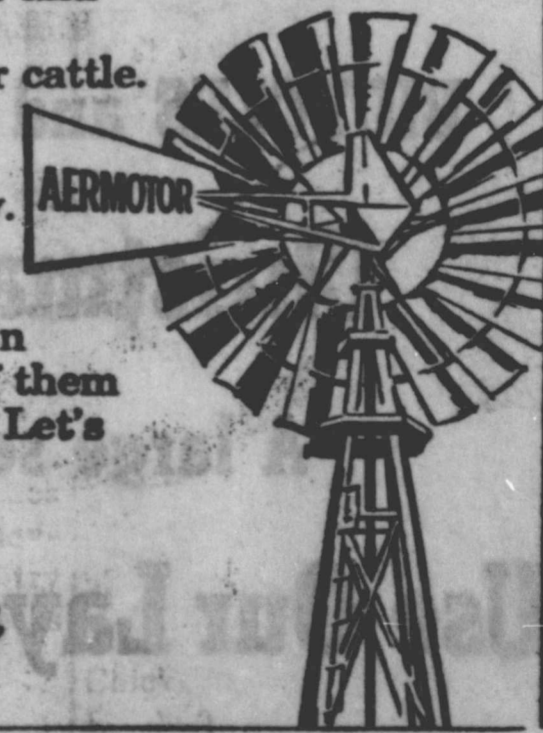
## Quail Season
