Primary Election

330 votes were cast in the first primary election here Saturday. For Sheriff, Truett Behrens had 147 votes, Frank Lindsey Jr 126 and the other four smaller amounts.

For Commissioner Buford Holland had 176, Junior Hill 140 and C. C. Ayers 24.

For County Supt Jerry Hawkins had 170 Richard Finch 98 and Maurick Risley 68.

Over the county, Behrens had 573 and Lindsey 411 which puts them into a runoff.

Including Lelia Lake, Holland had 192, Junior Hill 175 and Ayers 68, putting Holland and Hill into a runoff.

Over the county, Hawkins had 839, Finch 405 and Risley 871, so that Hawkins is the winner without a runoff in this race.

The Hedley voters chose the Jimmy Carter delegation.

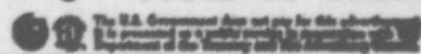
