The Hedley Schools today anmounced its policy for free and reduced lunches for children unable to pay the full price for meals serwed under the National School Lunch Program.

Children from families whose orally or in writing, to either: focome meets those indicated on the attached charts are eligible for free meals In, addition, familine not meeting these crireria lay, 856-3661 but with other unusual expenses due to unusually high medical exphases shelter costs in excess of 30% of income, special education expenses due to the mental or physical sondition of a child, and disaster casualty losses are urged to apply

Application forms will be given to students when they enroll in classes Additional copies are available at the principal's officel The information provided on the application is confidential and will be used only for the purpose of determining elipibility Applications may be submitted at any time during the year.

In certain cases foster children are also eligible for these behefite. If a family has foster children living with them and wish to apply for free meals you should centact the school.
