Lone Star Files For Rate Increase

Helleyt Dec 9, 1976-Lone er, A E Swearingen, today filled an application for a rate incresses to provide the company an 8% rate of return

Swearingto said Lone Star's ley earned a (4 78)% rate of res turn in 1975 and that \$9303.00 is required to correct the utility's revenue deficiency. He explained that Lone Star has experienced increased costs of operation the to the current inflation, and unrecovered costs of purchased gas which substantially eroded utility earbings.

In June of last your, the Rails road Commission authorized Lone Star to recover 65% of its increase in the average cost of gas (above a bask of ,72 cents) from resident tial and commercial deliveries at the city gate. During the four teen months ended August, 1976, Hone Star had unrecovered gas costs of \$14 2 million for gae de livered at the city gate for read dential and commercial customers

the last few years For example our average cost of gas climbed from 18¢ per thousand cubic fees in 1971 to \$1 03 in Jane of this year, a 472% increase. Utility barnings declined from \$23,3 millibn in 1971 to \$13.1 million in 1975, or 44%," Swearingen baid!
