Public Warned

The Social Security Administration District Office in Amarillo has received reports from the public that they are being contacted by a man who is falsely representing himself as an employee of the Social Security Administration, reports Jim Talbot, District Manager. "He uses the guise of one of our employees and tells the people that if they are receiving Supplemental Security Income, they are now required to pay eight dollars a month just to receive SSI," says Talbot. "Those who are on SSI are in no way obligated to pay a fee for receiving these benefits."

Home Fire Safety

A home burns every 45 seconds in the United States, resulting in 7,000 fire deaths annually. Since at least one-fourth of these victims are children under 14, parents should teach their children how to survive a home fire, emphasized a safety engineer with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. Home fire drills can save the lives of many children, and a publication by the Extension Service can help parents provide the needed safety training.
