However, yields will be down in Texas due to drought conditions. Corn and sorghum prices should be near the 1978 rate in the coming weeks.

Winter Pastures Increasing

More and more Texas farmers and ranchers are planting winter pastures, says a forage specialist with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. The main reasons are that hay supplies are short due to the drought and that winter pastures can provide high quality grazing during the winter and early spring. Planting wheat, oats or ryegrass on a prepared seedbed is best although they can also be seeded into bermudagrass sod.

The production and processing of this natural fiber generates over \$2 billion in the state's economy each year.


More than 27,500 businesses in Texas are centered around cotton and provide jobs for 69,448 Texans.

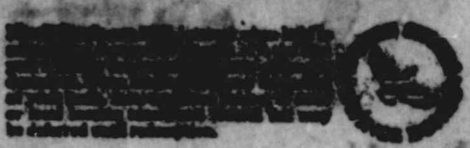
