There are places in restaurants where smokers are not allowed to sit. If you are also in a group or
club, ask if the person would club, ask if the person would
please not smoke or if he is still please not smoke or if he is still
going to smoke, to be by a ventilated area or window. Many
cities have laws which restrict cities have laws which restrict smoking in public places, such as
restaurants, civic buildings and business offices.
