Should I buy life insurance on my child＇s life？

Lynn Reagan，CLU This is a question that I have heard debated many times ove thought of＂profiting＂from the death of child is morally repre－ hensible．For others，the over－
whelming need for financial whelming need for financial
security overrides any moral securidation．
trepian
Over the years，I have dealt
with people at both ends of this spectrum．Today my advice to all is this：＂Yes，life insurance hould be purchased on your
hild＇s life．＂ The main reason for buying life insurance on anyone＇s life is to replace income＂lost＂or
pay for expenses caused by the death of the insured person．
If your child dies，there＇s no
lost income，but there will be lost income，but there will be funeral，burial，medical and re－
lated expenses that could run lated expenses that could run
to thousands of dollars，which might cause a financial hardship to the parents of the deceased child．
My most memorable experi－
ence with life insurance on a ence with life insurance on a
child＇s life occurred more than 20 years ago．
The parents of a perfectly healthy（by all appearances and
verifiable medical history）five－ year old girl purchased a
$\$ 10,000$ policy on the child＇s $\$ 10,000$ policy on the child＇s
life．

They paid the first monthly premium with the application．
The policy was issued and ready for delivery two weeks later， but the entire family was no－ here to be found
One of their neighbors in－
formed us that the family was at the Le Bonheur Children＇s Medical Center in Memphis，
Tennessee，where the child was waiting for a donor for a liver
tempted．Both transpplants failed and the child diet．The claim against the policy was honored
and the parents received the $\$ 10,000$ ．
Another reason for buying
life insurance on a child＇s life is to guard against the possibil－
ity that，when the child is older he or she might not be able to
buy life insurance because of in－ tervening illness or other cir－
cumstance． cumstan
A children＇s term rider on a
parent＇s policy can also protect parent＇s policy can also
against this possibility．
Still another reason for buy－
ng life insurance on a life is part of a program to teach the child financial responsibil
ity．

Typically the insurance is
whole life or universal life in－ whole life or universal life in－
surance，ownership of which is
transferred to the child when he transferred to the child when he or she turns 21
Most insurance advisors rec－
ommend that families spend their insurance budget to buy fec and disability income insur－
ance on the parents first，before considering insurance on children＇s lives．
Death of a parent，particu－ lary an income－earner，could
have financial consequences hat are devastating compared child＇s death．
This is good advice，espe－
cially when you consider that the child＇s coverage can take the form of a very inexpensive，
rider on one of the parents． rider on
policies．
Yes，you should buy life in－ Moreover，you should not de－ lay the purchase．
The uncertainty of life＇s fu－ ure events dictates immediate
action．Accidents and illnesses action．Accidents and illnesses
do not postpone themselves un－ til we are＂ready＂for them．Life is a hard teacher．It usually
