## "Prologue - Assault on a Bishop"

An angry mob breaks into a bishop's official residence. They search for him, going from room to room until they find him. They drag him outside and pressure him to agree to their demands. He refuses and says that if necessary he will suffer just as Christ had to suffer.

This type of language only makes them more infuriated, and some of them press forward, tearing off his pectoral cross, ripping his cape, and then assaulting him. He tells them that automatic excommunication is the penalty for attacking a bishop, but they pay no heed, dragging him off and imprisoning him. They hold him until late at night, their mood growing uglier with every moment, his life in imminent danger

The mob thinks he has insulted some of their deceased relatives; they shout that they have plenty of weapons. Finally a local leader manages to persuade the crowd to disperse, and the bishop narrowly escapes their clutches.
"This didn't happen during the Middle Ages, or more recently, under a totalitarian regime. This incident happened in March 1995, in an at least nominally Catholic European area.
"The Bishop in question was Bishop Ratko Peric, the ordinary of Mostar in Bosnia Herzegovina, a region which was shrouded in obscurity until the 1980s, when the events at a small village called Medjugorje started to become famous in the Catholic Church and beyond.
"Bishop Peric's crime was that as part of the restructuring of his diocese, he had asked the local Franciscan friars to stop using the church hall, which had functioned as their parochial center, and to take up some new appointments.
