nation, This was the turning point in the interpretation of the
First Amendment First Amendment. This prohib-
ited public practice of religious ited public practice of religious
activity. No longer was the intent of the First Amendment to prohibit a federally established
church, now the interpretation church, now the interpretation
was to prohibit any public pracwas to prohibit any public prac-
tice of religious activity. Never before in ay of the
founding doctrines of our counfounding doctrines of our coun-
try had this definition been writ ten or documented.

Scuool prayer was the fir asualty from this ruling by the Supreme Court which was base
on NO PRECEDENTS. The se-
ond casualty of this and succeed ond casualty of this and succeed-
ing rulings was that no religious doctrines could be espoused.
This meant that Biblical reference and textbooks would be removed from education. Clas-
sic teaching materials such as sic teaching materials such
the Bible Study Course of th New Testament, published for
Dallas High Schools in Sept Dallas High Schools in Sept. 1946 were stricken from usable
teaching materials. This had been apching materials. This had been Texas Board of Education, April 23, 1946. This had been a credit course toward graduation in Dallas High Schools! The supreme Court reaf-
firmed the ban on school prayer
and banned school Bible readand banned school Bible read-
ing on June 17,1963 in the cases ing on June 17,1963 in the cases
of Abington vs. Schempp and Murray vs. Curlett. In these cares, the court ruled that "I portions of the New Testament
were read without explanation, were read without explanation,
they could be...and had been they could be... and had been
psychologically harmful to the chychologically harmful to the
child." The trend continued case afer case, year after year. Stone
Graham in 1980 . lared "that hanging the Ten Commandments on a wall of a
school was illegal because it school was illegal because it
might induce children to read
it!"
