meeting of City Council on meeting of City Council on
Tuesday. The ordinance stated that a person holding a valid food managers' certificate was to be on the premises any time the establishment was open for
business. After some discussion regarding the feasibility of a certified individual being on site
during all hours of during all hours of operation,
the Ordinance 2009-05-14, Sec the Ordinance 2009-05-14, Sec-
tion 2B, was amended to read: The owner or person in charge
of the food establishment must possess a valid food managers certificate issued by the state ac-
credited certification program and that the certified food man ager be held liable and or re-
sponsible for any violation dursponsible for any violation during hours of operation. The
ordinance passed without oppo sition.

Should you add "munis" to your portfolio?

ivest in them. But should you? Before you can answer that question, you need to know what hey work. General obligation onds are backed by property axes and finance projects from nd states. Res, school districts backed by a specific revenue source and finance hospitals, utilities, airports, affordable housing and other public works. So when you invest in a revenue civic-minded, although you aren't confined to bonds issued by your city or state. You can get other tangible benefits from "munis." First you'll receive regular interest payments. Just as importantly, these payments ypically are exempt from federal income taxes and possibly cate and local income taxes as well. Keep in mind, however, hat they may be subject to the
Iternative minimum tax. Consequently, if you're in an upper tax bracket, you may be especially interested in munis. Still, before investing in a muni,
you'll want to determine its yield. Basically, a bond's yield any given return it promises and's price rises its, when a ally falls, and vice versa. The longer the time to a bond's maturity, the greater its interest rate free mumi to that of a yaxable bond you must calculate its tax-equivalent yield, which is based on the mun's interest rate and your inditis say tax bracket. For example, free muni that pays $4 \%$ interest and you're in the $28 \%$ tax bracket, To determine the bond's taxquivalent yield, subtract your 72. Then divide the bond's yau or .4 , by .72 , giving you $5.5 \%$, or .4, by .72 , giving you $5.5 \%$.
This means you would need to find a taxable bond that pays at least $5.5 \%$ to equal the yield of a tax-free muni paying 4\%. Even if you've determined
that a tax-free muni's yield compares favorably to that of a taxable bond, you need to assess ome of the potential risks of owning munis. For one thing, nunicipalities are clearly not
exempt from the effects of the exempt from the effects of the
ong and harsh recession we've experienced. Consequently, some exrojects funded by munis may have rouble generating the revenue tors. Another potential issue to consider with munis is their liquidy. Some states, such as New York and Califormia, issue a great many bonds, which are traded regularly.
But some municipalities operate in more illiquid markets, so if you buy a muni from one of these issuers, you may need to hold it until it matures. Also, munis are
traded "over the counter" rather than on an exchange, so it can sometimes be difficult to get a price quote for your bond, not to mention a buyer. These liquidity issues may not matter to
you, however, if you intend to
hold your bond until maturity hold your bond until maturity,
collecting regular interest payments along the way and evenally receiving your principal
back. There is also credit risk when investing in bonds, where if the issuer defaults you could potentially lose all of your prin-
cipat. In any cipal. In any case, as long as
you've done your research and otten help from a qualified financial professional, you may find that municipal bonds can
