Speed Up: Highway 90 speed increases to 70

A drive east or west on Highway 90 looks a little different, but did you notice?
Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT)

officials have gradually been removing the 65mile per hour signs since September 1, said TxDOT Public Information Officer Raul Leal.

"The 82nd Texas Legislature passed and the Governor signed House Bill 1353, which takes effect on September 1. This legislation allows the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to create a 75-mile per hour speed limit on any state highway found to be reasonable and safe through a speed study. TxDOT will be reviewing existing 70-mile per hour speed limits to determine where a 75-mile per hour speed limit may be safely posted. HB 1353 also eliminates the 65-mile per hour nighttime speed limit and all truck speed



limits. On September 1, the existing nighttime and truck speed limits are repealed and no longer enforceable. TxDOT awarded maintenance contracts in August to remove the nighttime and truck speed limit signs and is also in the process of hiring consultants to perform the required speed studies needed to implement the higher speed limits," said TxDOT in August.

The removal of the signs from the 50,000 miles of Texas highways is expected to be completed by the end of the month.

Owls have even been known to prey upon unlucky cats and dogs. Great horned owls are largely nocturnal so they can be difficult to spot,' nationalgeographic.com.
