## Residue Study Results Told

| completed at the High Plains Research Foundation this past season might be useful to farmers in planning this year's cropping operations. <br> Herbicide residue due to the increased and repeated usage tends to pose problems in planning crop rotation, A specific herbicide rate providing full season weed control may period, thus causing damage to succeeding crops. <br> The residue study was inItlated in 1967 with cooperCompany in the study Propazine 80 W and an experimental herbicide GS 14260-80W, now marketed under the brand name of Igran. These herbicldes were applied alone and 1967 at 100,200 , and 400 per cent of the recommended rate on grain sorghum. <br> Wheat was planted following sorghum harvest in the cotton in the spring of 1968 . Residue carry-over from Propazine at the recommended rate of 1.25 pounds per |
