The presence of this asbestos
will force the school board and the walministration to make some
decisins decisions in the near future. These
decisions are going to be forced by the fact that those school districts
that are not in compliance with the that are not in compliance with th
act by October 1988 can be fined
from from $\$ 5,000$ to $\$ 30,000$ a day until they get in compliance. I do no
know of many school district know of many school districts tha AHERA is a federal mandate-.There have been no federa to tus provided for school districts each district will have to foot its own bill. This type of mandat the number one consideration should be the safety of those who must occupy our buildings. We are presently in the process assist us in getting in compliance assist us in getting in compliance
with the act. Even though there is asbestos in our building, it poses no threat to occupants because it is contained in the tunnels beneat the building.
