## OSTON, the beautiful

 Puritan city, has many gateways through winich the pulgrims upon whatever errand bent, mayenter her goodly precincts. And she has much to offer, all who may come to her, the way of historic relics, and tacilities for study or bus iness. Her older streets may be winding and narrow, but they are picturesque and full of suggestions of that past in which all Americans have an interest, and of which they have a right to be proud. Many of the quaint old thoroughfares lead to shrines which, as long as they exist will attract tourists and will help to keep alive feeling potriotism and loyalty.
