Late yesterday evening $P$. C. Kichardson reported to A J. Spradley that some one had broke into his house on the Banita creek south of the square, and requested Spradley to take his dogs and put down till dark the dogs kept up a lively chase, up and down the creek, over logs, railroad trestles and such places as rambling boys resort to. The trail was brought to town and four boys, three from Lufkin and one who lives in Nacogdoches were suspected when they were presented with criminating circumstances, one of them broke down and give the whole transaction away. The Lufkin boys were locked up in the calaboose to prevent them from leaving as witnesses and
