The democratic executive ommittee at Fort Worth ast Saturday called a primary lection for Saturday, May 2. The call bars negroes trom It provides that the names $f$ the. Bailey candidates for delegates at large to the national democratic conven ion, who are to be nominat d at Fort Worth March 28 , nd of the anti-Bailey eandidates nominated at Waco March 7, shall be placed in parallel columns on an officia one, two, three and four in each column.
It provides that the numer one eandidate receiving nost votes shall be elected by he state convention a dele ate to the national conven tion and so on with numbers
two, three and tour in each

This pits Senator Bailey gainst Cone Johnson per onally, since Mr. Johnson is number one candidate on the Waco ticket and Senato number one on the Forle North ticket.
It is further provided that ropresiding officer of each ngig box shall appoint one Catik to be designated by the wnti-Bailey men and one by the Bailey men in said preinct.
The state committee, by its action, frankly committed Bailey leaders that it is im possible to hold such a rimary as this one that shal e. legal, except insofar as the committee "in the ex-
