The lost suffered by the road during the revoluion is estimated at $\mathbf{3 2 0 0 , 0 0 0}$. Construction of the com: pany's lines on the Mexican side has been practically at a standstill during the unsetsled condition of affairs in
Mexico. The completion of the 1,045 miles for which the company bas concessions requires between $\$ 15,000,000$ and $\$ 20,000,000$ but the lines need tall of 1920 .
