We have chosen the $\mathrm{V}-8$-a motor with two banks of cylinders set at an angle opposite each other, instead of all eight cylinders in a line there are good reasons for this.

When we take 8 cylinders and set them four on a side, the length of he motor is reduced about half; it becomes a sturdy and compact power plant.
