| On an unprecedented scale priests and ministers (and nuns) from both the Roman Catholic and Protestant branches of the Church. <br> In a recentstudy of the Roman Catholic situation Time Magazine concluded that the chief married. It said: "The vast majority are in honest rebellion against what they feel is an authoritarian, outmoded church organization that unfairly limits their freedoms and responsibilities and frustrates their desire to serve God by serving man." Surely there is no work in life where it is so important to be completely happy and dedicated in one's vocation. <br> We need also to remember th thousands who have faced the alternatives and decided to stay. Typical of these is Dr. John M. Krumm, an Episcopa John M. Krumm, an Episcopal rector in New York City, who says: "The Spirit is taking the things of Christ-his life, his teaching, his death and resur-rection-and showing us what it all means in a new and very different day and situation. <br> That is one of the reasons I would not think of leaving the church at this exciting moment in its life and history.... As I see it, the Church is in an uproar and a revolution, and I want to be where the action is, and to help experiment and shaping of the church of the future. |
