

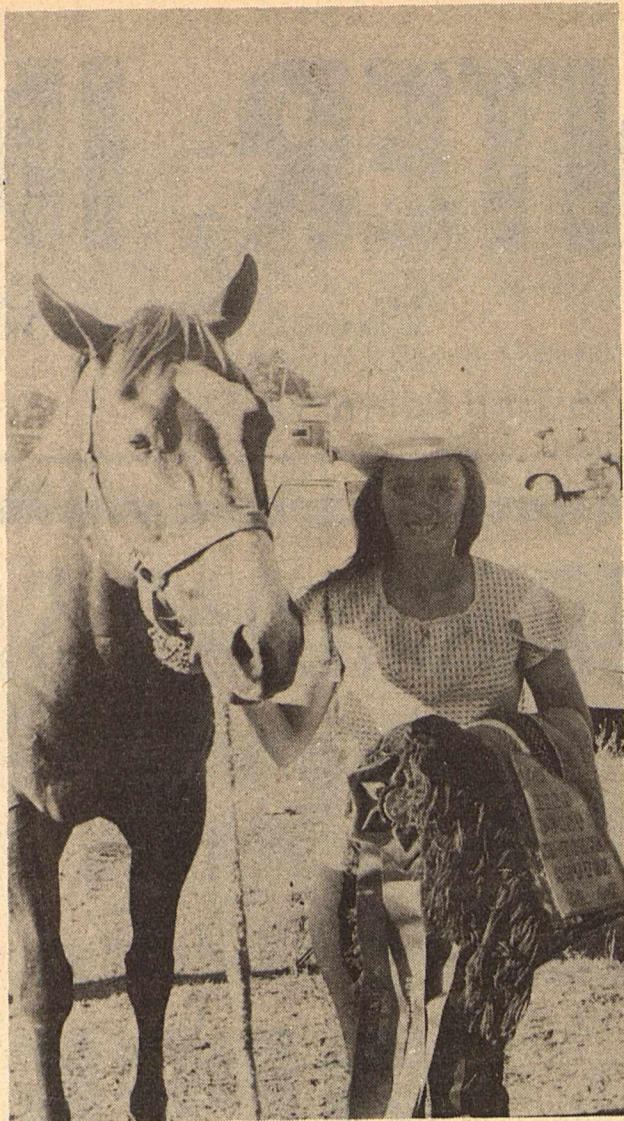

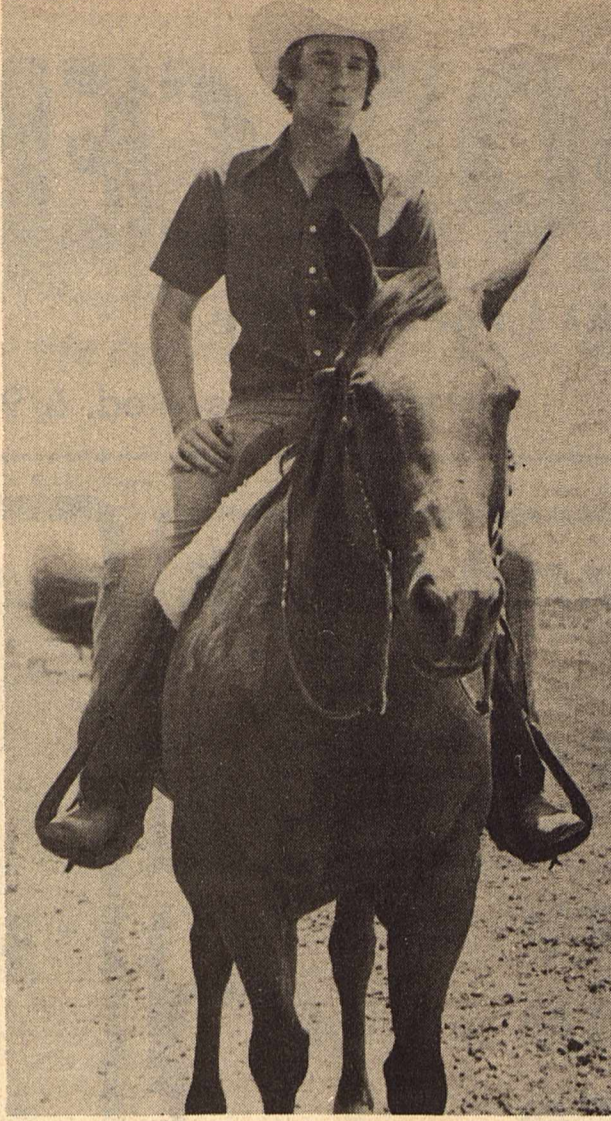


76 Attend Trail Ride

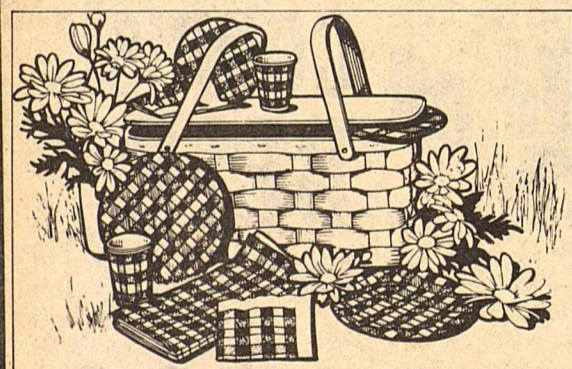

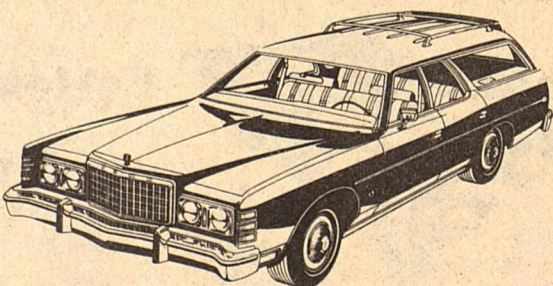

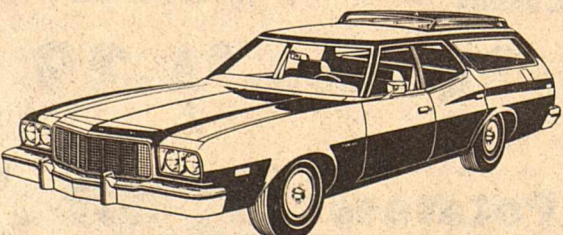
