## Green Thumb trains workers

For the hundreds of older workers in the Green Thumb senior employment program, responsibility has been a way of life, an essential part of the traditional work ethic that most older persons accept.

But as 50 Green Thumb workers meeting at the Multi-Purpose Center in Eden learned recently, responsibility goes beyond caring for jobs and families; it also means being responsible for your own health.

"Working hard is the most important thing in many people's lives," said Green Thumb assistant director John Willingham. "Yet what most of us don't think about is that we can't work if we aren't healthy, and to be healthy we have to take care of ourselves."

Green Thumb provides part time work in public service agencies for low-income persons 55 and over. Texas Farmers Union sponsors the program, which operates in 108 counties across the state.

Willingham emphasized that it is far better to prevent a disease than to deal with it after it has attacked the body, and in a film produced by the American Occupational Medical Association, the Green Thumbers learned how diet, exercise, and good habits can forestall the onset of disease.

Richard P. Sanchez, 39, died at 7:30 a.m. October 7, 1983 at Baylor Hospital in Dallas.

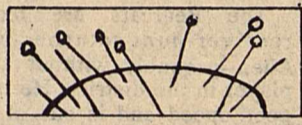

## All Texas Air Tour in Sonora

The skies over Sonora were a spectacular sight Tuesday afternoon with about 30 planes with the All Texas Air Tour flying in for a 30 minute stop in Sonora. Don King, president of the West Texas Flyers and this year's vice president of the All Texas Air Tour led the group in for the landing, from Lajitas where they enjoyed a Mexican buffet.

This is the 35th year for the All Texas Air Tour which was started shortly after World War II by H.W. Bahnam, a former president of the Texas State Aviation Association.

The tour began Monday, October 2, leaving Temple Texas with plans to stop at Brenham, New Braunfels, Junction for short stops and on to San Angelo for over night. Towns on the tour included Iraan, Lajitas, Sonora, Eagle Pass, Breckenridge, Mineral Wells, Brownwood, Monahans, Midland, Big Spring and back to San Angelo. The tour will last for a week giving the people with the tour a chance to see and get acquainted with Texas.

The tour is open to anyone with an airplane and an interest in aviation. Members of the tour come from all over the United States, with less than 50 percent of the tour being from Texas. A Mr. Springer from Florida is over 80 years old and has been with the tour over 30 years.

The purpose of the All Texas Air Tour, besides fun, is to develop an interest and appreciation of aviation and to advance aviation education both for airplane owners and at the community level. King is extending an invitation to area pilots to join the air tour even if for just a one-day trip out with the group. Anyone

## Livestock prices to improve

Cattle, hog and lamb prices should improve slightly for the rest of the year and could make some strong gains in 1984, says an economist in livestock marketing with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, Texas A&M University System. Cattle feedlot marketings should be down sharply in the last quarter of 1983 while hog slaughter should remain

high. However, hog slaughter should drop seasonally in the first and second quarters of 1984. Choice fed steers may average in the mid- to upper-\$60s by

the second quarter of '84 while hog prices should increase to \$42 to \$46 during the first quarter. Choice lambs could average in the upper-\$50s to low-\$60s next year.
