

IRA warnings given by Security Board

Due to a recent number of local solicitations by a group that apparently misrepresented material facts about their organization and its investment opportunities, Al Elliott, a local attorney, contacted an attorney in the enforcement division for the State Security Board concerning IRA account solicitors.

A group (or groups) of persons have apparently misrepresented themselves as being employees of "Financial organizations" seeking investors for the Individual Retirement Accounts in Sonora and it is feared that other solicitors will be here again. The attorney contacted by Elliott suggested the

following questions for citizens to ask if they are approached by such persons or organizations, either by phone or in person offering IRA's or Keogh retirement plan investments: 1. What is the name and address of every company

that will handle my money? Where will my money be deposited? In whose name is that account? 2. What commissions and fees must I pay? At the end

of the first year, how much money will I have left in my account after fees and commissions are deducted? 3. Is my money insured by the FDIC or any other

entity?

4. Will my money go out of state? 5. What interest rate will my money earn? Is this rate guaranteed? For how long will my money earn this rate? What is being done with my money to generate this interest rate?

6. What written materials do I have on this company? Am I given a chance to carefully read these materials before I sign up? Am I left a copy of everything I sign at

IN FIRST 1983 DISTRICT GAME

Broncos fall 7-3

The Sonora Broncos lost a very hard-fought and well-played game against the Crane Golden Cranes in the last 1:12 of the game on a desperation fourth down pass and a prayer.

The Sonora Broncos took a 3-0 lead with 5:00 minutes to play on a 34 yd. field goal by Scott Miller.

The Broncos kicked off and on third down the Cranes fumbled and the Broncos' noseguard Ronnie Munns came up with the ball on the Crane 42 yard line. The Broncos moved down the field looking to put the Cranes

On third and 15 yards for a first, fullback Tino Martinez ran for 11 yards down inside the Crane 35 yard line only to fumble after a very hard hit by several Crane defenders. This gave the Cranes new life with 2:43 left in the game. On first down Crane's tailback Joe Vasquez ran for nine. On the next play quarterback Jim Vasquez passed to his wide receiver between two Bronco defenders for a 20 yard reception.

The Cranes then got one more first down on three rushing plays setting up 1st and 10 on the Bronco 35 yard line. On first down the Bronco defense stopped the Cranes for 1 yard. On the next play the Cranes got a holding penalty and nullified an 8 yard pass

On the next play the Cranes got part of the yardage back on a sweep right setting up 3rd down and eight. The next play was an incomplete pass thus leaving the Cranes with one last play to get a first down.

The Cranes called their last time out to talk things over with 1:23 left to play in the game. Cranes coach Ricky White reached deep into his bag of tricks and pulled out a play from the back of the playbook. He sent the backup quarterback into the game and moved starting quarterback Vasquez to wide receiver on the

The play was simple--run to the endzone, throw the ball to the endzone as high as possible and outjump the defense and catch the ball. That is just what happened as Vasquez outjumped a Sonora defender at the one-yard line and fell into the endzone for the winning score.

This puts the pressure on the Broncos as a district play as they probably can't lose another game and hope to make the playoff.

On the other hand, it is very conceivable that the two

best teams played already here at Bronco Stadium and both the Cranes and the Broncos could win the rest of their games and both be in the playoffs.

Tino Martinez again was the biggest part of the Bronco offense. He ran for 123 yards on 24 carries. Victor Lira ran for 39 yards and Joe Mike Noriega for

In the passing department Jeff Brittain was 0 of 2 and 1 intercepted before leaving the game at the start of the second period with an injured arm after a huge hit on the Crane tailback on 4th and 1 at the Sonora goalline stopping him short of the score.

Drew Wallace was 1 of 7 for 10 yards. The one completion was to Joe Will Ross.

Elsewhere around the District 6-AAA, Ballinger (6-0) won over Ozona (3-3) 34-13, and Colorado City (4-2) beat Coahoma (3-3) 27-6. This next week Crane will play at Coahoma and Colorado City will play at Ozona.

The Broncos will go north to take on the defending champions, the Ballinger Bearcats. Last year the Bearcats lost only one district game and that was 7-0 to the Broncos.

That will be foremost in the minds of the Bearcats when they take the field Friday at Ballinger. The situation is much the same again this year. Ballinger 6-0 and the Broncos coming off a narrow loss to the

The Bearcats are led by running back-wide receiver-punt returner-punter-kick returner Matt Allen--probably without a doubt the most versatile player in the district. He is an excellent receiver with good speed and is one of the West Texas leaders in receiving yardage.

Ballinger also has All-District quarterback last season running their offense in Aaron Keesee. He is a good runner and a super drop back passer as his statistics are among the tops in West Texas.

The Bearcats also have two fine running backs in Fisher and Brevard who are both averaging nearly 100 yards per game.

The game will be another tough physical test for the Broncos. This may be difficult as the Broncos are pretty beat up with minor injuries and bruises after this past


Efforts to establish some off-campus adult education courses for the Sonora area are continuing according to superintendent of Sonora schools, W.A. McAndrew.

Green Thumb trains workers

For the hundreds of older workers in the Green Thumb senior employment program, responsibility has been a way of life, an essential part of the traditional work ethic that most older persons accept.

But as 50 Green Thumb workers meeting at the Multi-Purpose Center in Eden learned recently, responsibility goes beyond caring for jobs and families; it also means being responsible for your own health.

"Working hard is the most important thing in many people's lives," said Green Thumb assistant director John Willingham. "Yet what most of us don't think about is that we can't work if we aren't healthy, and to be healthy we have to take care of ourselves.

Green Thumb provides part time work in public service agencies for low-income persons 55 and over. Texas Farmers Union sponsors the program, which operates in 108 counties across the state.

Willingham emphasized that it is far better to prevent a disease than to deal with it after it has attacked the body, and in a film produced by the American Occupational Medical Association, the Green Thumbers learned how diet, exercise, and good habits can forestall the onset of disease.
