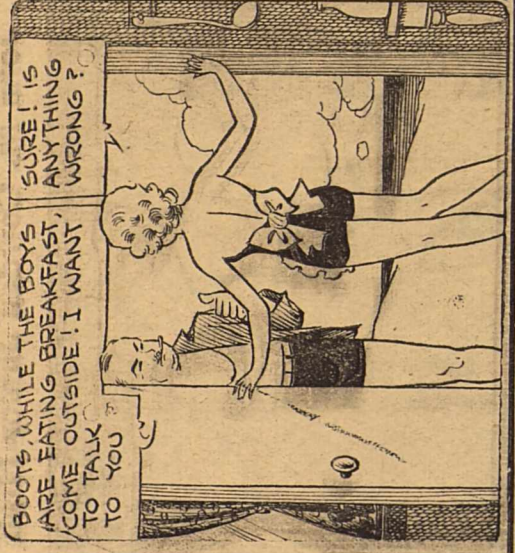
**RELAYED SUCCESS.**
