And there can be no bars on the outside windows. Vandal-proof plumbing, cannot be installed under the federal rules. The open design of the jail-large
recreation areas are required-also will require the hiring of at least four additional full-time deputies at a cost of about $\$ 48,000$ a year over the present payroll.
