The director of the Department of Public Safety today called on all holiday drivers to substantially improve their driving safety consciousness; otherwise, the Christmas and New Year's holiday periods

may claim as many as 95 lives. Colonel Jim Adams said 'we realize the added dangers of traveling by motor vehicle during these holiday periods and we want to help avoid the tragedy and suffering which could mar this otherwise happy season.'

Adams believes that "we don't have to continue suffering the spiraling traffic deaths if drivers use extreme caution in traveling on the streets and highways in Texas."

During the first 10 months of 1980 there were 356,896 motor vehicle accidents in Texas in which 153,099 persons suffered personal injuries. Adams said that in the comparable 1979 period, there were 372,448 accidents in

Texas during which 153,884 persons were hurt. The total motor vehicle accidents are down 4.2 per cent when compared to the same period last year.

Adams said that statewide traffic deaths are presently running about three per cent ahead of the record pace of a year ago, in which 4,229 persons were killed in motor vehicle crashes.

When comparing the first 10 months of this year against 1979 figures, Adams indicated that during the January-October period, the state had counted 3,109 fatal accidents in which 3,562 persons were killed. In the first 10 months of 1979, there had been 2,968 fatal accidents, resulting in 3,415 deaths. This reflects a 4.3 per cent increase over the

comparable time frame. During the first 11 months of this year, there have been 3,855 motor vehicle deaths, of

which 2,044 have been recorded in cities and towns with the remaining 1,811 occurring in rural areas.

Adams estimated that 58 persons would be killed in motor vehicle accidents during the Christmas holiday weekend and another 37 persons would be killed during the New Year holiday weekend. Both holiday periods are 102 hours long.

He said the Christmas count starts at 6 p.m. Wednesday, December 24 and continues until midnight, Sunday December 28. The New Year holiday count starts at 6 p.m. Wednesday, December 31 and ends at midnight, Sunday, January 4, 1981.


Adams said that during the Christmas holiday period last year 72 persons were killed in traffic and 43 were killed during the New Year holiday period.

'During both forthcoming

major holidays, our traveling public has an opportunity to take advantage of slower speeds while helping our law enforcement officers across Texas reduce the spiraling death toll. I would certainly urge all drivers to utilize only wise driving habits and caution while on the roadways. In so doing, our motorists would be in a better position to live to enjoy the full

holidays," he added. Adams also reminded motorists that many lives would be saved and serious injuries would be reduced during the crowded driving time through greater utilization of seat belts and other restraint devices.

All available DPS Troopers will be on duty throughout both holidays. They will be joining with local officers to place special emphasis on removing drunks and reckless drivers from city streets and highways.

## **Stenholm Looking Forward To 97th Congress**

Stenholm called the back-andforth budget battle between the House and Senate "an exercise that marked the frustration and futility of efforts to during the 96th Congress."

The week-long battle between the two Congressional continuing appropriations bill ended in the early hours centering on a Congressional pay raise issue and some 150 Senate "Christmas tree" spending amendments.

It was near-dawn before the vote. House and Senate finally agreed to cut the controversial pay raise proposal which would have increased salaries of members of Congress and for federal employees at GS Reagan administration had

Congressman Charles W. repeatedly backed the increase, feeling the higher pay scale was necessary to secure high-quality personnel for the new administration.

"I have felt all along that if keep federal spending in line Congress wasn't willing to draw the spending line on Congressional salaries and those of the high-level bureaubodies over approval of the crats, we were failing to keep austerity commitments so freely voiced to the folks back Tuesday morning (December home, both before and after 16) after days of bitter debate the election," Stenholm said. "I have opposed a Congressional pay increase since the first time the issue came up and I opposed it on this last

Stenholm also pointed out that the Senate spending amendments, most of which were finally defeated, would have reportedly cost more than \$1 billion. "We'll have to grades 15 and above. The wait for a complete budget

analysis now to find out just what level of spending we finally approved," he continued. "And I can almost guarantee that I won't like it, but we found that a lame duck Congress can be an unwieldy and obstinate creature. The free spending Senate had been badly wounded by the November 4 elections, but was determined to go down hard."

Stenholm said some meritorious proposals, including a \$20,000 tax break for missionaries serving abroad, were killed along with the more reckless spending proposals tacked onto the bill by the

"Right now, however, I'm looking ahead to the 97th Congress," he said, "with high hopes that our accomplishments next year will far outweigh any disappointments suffered during the 96th Congress."

## **Cotton Classing**

B.B. Manly reported that the 1980-81 cotton harvest was finally resumed and that 8200 cotton samples were classed at the USDA Cotton Marketing Services Office in Abilene during the week ending December 19. Some cotton producers and gin managers who thought that they would be practically finished harvesting and ginning cotton by now are just getting started. The low yields and weather interruptions have curtailed harvesting to the extent that only 72,000 samples have been classed in Abilene to date, which compares to 568,000 samples classed by the same time last season. An additional 8100 samples have been classed at the Munday

Local cotton prices were firm to slightly higher during the past week, closing 1 to 2 cents per pound higher for the week. Prices were mostly 331/2 to 351/2 cents per pound over CCC loan values for staple 31 or longer cotton, and 28 to 32 cents per pound over the loan

for staple 30 or shorter cotton. Physical prices for the most prevalent qualities ranged from 64 to 79 cents per pound. Demand was moderate, but the supply of cotton continued light. Trading was slow to moderate, slightly more active than during the previous

Cottonseed prices paid producers at gins were steady to \$10 per ton lower, ranging from \$110 to \$130 per ton.

Mr. Manly reported that the quality of cotton classed in Abilene during the past week was slightly lower than that classed the previous week. Grades and fiber length have been of lower quality than usual all season, but micronaire readings have been mostly within the desirable 35 to 49 range. Cotton classed last week was about 2% white grades, 46% light-spotted, 51% spotted, and about 1% tinged grades. Grade 53 comprised 24%, grade 52 comprised 23%, grade 43 comprised 21%, and grade 42 accounted for 20% of the

samples classed. About 7% of the total classings were below grade (BG's). Fiber length was 39% staple 31, 25% staple 32, and 22% staple 30; with the average staple being 31.1. Micronaire readings were 93% with the 35 to 49 range, and averaged 42. About 37% of the samples classed were reduced in grade because of grass or bark content. Fiber strength tests averaged 85,000 pounds per square inch breaking strength during the past week and also

### MERRY CHRISTMAS! **VA News**

October 1, 1980, marked the start of a new year for CHAMPUS outpatient deductibles. According to C.H. Herren, Veterans Service Officer for Haskell County, Civilian Health and Medical Program for Uniformed Services (CHAMPUS) is the Government-sponsored program that provides health and medical care to retired milidependents. Under this program, needed medical care in most cases is obtained through civilian sources rather than from military clinics and hospitals. Under the plan, the private insurance carrier will pay 75% of the cost of hospitalization and other inpatient care, and the individual must pay the other 25 %. Payment for outpatient care is by the same 75%-25% ratio, but only after an established

deductible amount has been paid by the patient. The outpatient deductible is the initial amount a beneficiary must pay each fiscal year before CHAMPUS costsharing is available for outpatient expenses, such as a physician's services in his office, etc. For an individual, the deductible is the first \$50 of authorized outpatient charges in a fiscal year. For a family of two or more persons filing claims, the deductible in

a fiscal year is \$100. The CHAMPUS year is the

fiscal year, from October 1 throught the following September 30. CHAMPUS beneficiaries should therefore be aware that a deductible that was satisfied during FY 1980 received after September 30, (October 1, 1979 through) September 30, 1980), cannot be applied to care received after September 30, 1980. Thus, a new outpatient deductible will have to be met for FY 1981, which commenced October 1, 1980.
